The Hospital Alliance for Research Collaboration (HARC) is an initiative of the Sax Institute in partnership with the Clinical Excellence Commission, the Agency for Clinical Innovation and the Bureau of Health Information.

HARC drives innovative thinking about emerging challenges in healthcare. It links researchers, health managers, clinicians and policy makers so they can share ideas.

HARC holds regular forums, publishes a monthly e-Bulletin and has established the HARC Scholarship Program. The HARC e-Bulletin is a monthly publication which brings the latest influential national and international reviews, research and reports to the 7000 clinicians, managers and policy makers in the HARC Network.

The HARC Scholarship Program encourages skill building in the area of integrating evidence from research into policy and practice. Through its scholarships, HARC supports future leaders to develop advanced skills in using research in policy making. It also helps them develop connections to national and international experts in health services research.
